

Operating Instructions Bain Marie BM / BMH

General Instruction

- Carefully read these operating instructions through as they contain important information.
- It is advisable to keep the operating instructions in a place where you have them always ready to hand. Should you pass the appliance on to a third party, this instruction manual must be handed on.
- As soon as you have unpacked the Bain Marie, check whether everything is in a faultless condition. Should anything be damaged, do not connect the appliance as such, but inform your dealer.
- The Bain Marie must only be used for the intended purpose. Improper use can cause damages and lead to the loss of the warranty.
- Before you connect the Bain Marie, make sure that the type of current stated on the identification plate corresponds with your mains power supply.
- In the case of fault and/or malfunction, pull the plug out of the socket and inform your dealer. He will carry out the repair with original spare parts.
- Please observe the local regulations concerning accident prevention and disposal.
- The manufacturer/dealer cannot be made responsible for damages which arise through not observing these operating instructions.

Safety Notes

- The Bain Marie may be only used, if water were filled into the interior before.
- Do not immerse the appliance in water or any liquid.
- Regularly check the cable. If it is damaged, it must exchanged by a qualified specialist.
- The cable must not hang over table edges and/or sharp edges.
- It must not come into contact with water.
- Do not use the cable to pull out the plug from the socket.
- Do not touch the plug with wet hands.
- Repairs may only be undertaken by a qualified specialist using original spare parts.
- Do not leave the appliance unattended while it is in use. Children are not able to realise dangers when handling electronic appliances.
- Before each cleaning, switch off the appliance and allow it to cool down. Then pull the plug out of the socket.
- Do not touch hot surfaces.
- Do not move the Bain Marie when hot water is in it.
- Before each cleaning unplug from outlet and also when not in use.



Instruction for use and cleaning

- 1. Place the appliance on a stable, flat and dry surface.
- 2. Before using the appliance clean it with a damp cloth or sponge and a commercial detergent. Wipe off and dry everything carefully.
- 3. Add water into the interior about 2 ½ cm till maximum 5 cm.
- 4. Connect the appliance with the power supply. The control lamp will illuminate.
- 5. Adjust the desired temperature with the toggle.
- 6. The heating-up time depends on the water temperature and can take a half hour.
- 7. Place the GN container into the Bain Marie.
- 8. If you turn the toggle on ZERO, the Bain Marie is switched off.
- 9. If there is any food residue remaining on the surface, it should be removed after each use.
- 10. It is essential to have the appliance cleaned on a daily basis.
- 11. Before each cleaning, switch off the appliance and allow it to cool down. Then pull the plug out of the socket.
- 12.Do not use aggressive detergents and under no circumstances steel wool or abrasive sponges.
